Airnergy Spirovital therapy: Quality rather than quantity

"Unable to change the human body, we change the air we breathe". These are the words of the developers of Airnergy therapy, who questioned traditional oxygen therapies and developed an internationally-patented method, which achieved such remarkable results that ten years later Airnergy is still celebrating its success.

Should O₂ be concentrated or optimally utilized? When it comes to oxygen, more is not necessarily better. The specialist media in particular is increasingly coming round to this view – Airnergy has long been convinced of it. Why give the body unnaturally high levels of oxygen when this leads to the production of more free radicals? Why add more oxygen when, as medicine has long known, around three quarters of the oxygen we breathe in is breathed out again unused?

And our ability to utilize oxygen is further compromised by chronic illness, lack of exercise, stress and increasing age ...

Oxygen: Quality rather than quantity True to its motto "Quality rather than quantity" Airnergy challenged itself to develop a gentle method of supporting the body in its ability to utilize oxygen from the atmosphere (21%). It does not increase the

quantity of oxygen nor does it ionize the oxygen or supplement it with ozone.

Administered at the right time, at the right place and in the correct dosage, the cells should then be able to utilize the oxygen to support self-healing and regeneration processes in the body and to enhance energy production (ATP). In this way Spirovital therapy supports cellular respiration within the body and not, as do the previous oxygen therapies, external respiration in the lungs and capillaries.

Finally, after many years of research, the Airnergy Company merely looked to nature to come up with a technical solution to treat the oxygen we breathe so that the human body recognizes it and can make optimum use of it in its cells.

Simulating photosynthesis By using artificial sunlight and a stable catalyst similar to natural chlorophyll it was possible to simulate an important part of the photosynthesis reaction. In this process the oxygen in the air is converted from the triplet state to the singlet state. However, as

we know from physics, this peak energetic state is only stable for a brief moment before it reverts back to its original state. The Spirovital system uses this state and the energy that is thereby released by binding it to water molecules in the air, which are then inhaled by the users via a lightweight nasal cannula.

Widely-tested and versatile It has been scientifically proven and demonstrated in both complementary and conventional medicine throughout the world that this method can stimulate the entire organism and thereby contribute to the alleviation of many different complaints. Exhaustion, sleep disturbances including sleep apnoea but also pain, COPD, eye conditions such as macular degeneration, fibromyalgia and ADS/ADHS are all improved by Spirovital therapy.

In complementary practices Spirovital therapy is used to support the body's own detoxification processes as well as other treatment modalities.

The regime might consist of several 20-minute treatments in one week or

courses of 10 or 20 treatments several times a year.

A study carried out by Prof. Kuno Hottenrott at the Martin Luther University in Halle an der Saale, with young healthy sports students as volunteers, showed that the function of the sympathetic nervous system had been measurably improved even during the course of a 20-minute treatment and there had been a reduction in heart rate.

And if the functional capacity of the central nervous system is improved, vital functions such as breathing, heart action, blood pressure, metabolism and hormone production can be better controlled and regulated. This can explain why the use of Spirovital therapy is so versatile and can be particularly beneficial from a medical point of view as a basic treatment.

"Energizes and calms at the same time." Professional sportsmen and women, such as Formula 1 champion Jenson Button and football coach Ottmar Hitzfeld, use Spirovital treatment to improve their recovery time and concentration or simply to help themselves feel well and relaxed. A service life of more than 10 years The small "Airnergy Spas" are no bigger than a briefcase and suitable for general use. All that is needed to install them in a practice is enough space for some seating and an electric socket. Airnergy devices are quiet and almost maintenance-free and, even if they are in continuous use, running costs are minimal.

Ongoing research ensures that the Airnergy systems with their patented activating units are constantly being improved, even though they are already designed for a service life of more than 10 years. According to the manufacturer and their customers, the first machines sold over 10 years ago are still providing users with a sterling service.

Machines will provide about 6,000 treatments or 2,000 hours of operation before they need servicing. Only the dust and bacterial filters need to be replaced on a regular basis, i.e. after every 50 hours of operation. Changing the air filter takes less than a minute.

The Airnergy Company is dedicated to quality and service. That is why the manufacturer has ISO 9001 certification for its quality management, ISO 13485 certification as a manufacturer of medical devices and ISO 14001 certification for its environmental policy.
